
Coordination of ITA with sectoral reform priorities

Tasks

- → Agreeing upon common mid-term results for reforms implementation based on approved reform strategies, sectoral/ministerial action plans (APs) and DPs programs/ projects;
- → Ensuring alignment of Ministerial APs and plans of DPs programs and projects, identifying areas for coordination and synergies, potentials for overlaps, underfunded areas;
- → Monitoring sectoral reforms implementation progress and contributions of the GoU and DPs;
- → Securing mainstreaming of cross-cutting issues into sectoral reforms;
- → Setting up thematic sub-groups (if needed), structuring and reviewing results of their work;
- → Ensuring documentation and open access to information on functioning of SWGs and thematic sub-groups;
- → Defining issues for coordination at inter-ministerial and Cabinet of Ministers levels (policy, strategic, legal frameworks and reforms related) for the DPP (the 2nd tier).

Working modalities

- → Sub-groups coordination: coordinators appointed by the relevant line ministry(ies) and DPs;
- → SWGs meetings quarterly (upon suggestion of either Co-Chair);
- → Sub-groups meetings as needed (upon suggestion of sub-groups coordinators);
- → Joint GoU-DPs Secretariat: meetings agenda setting, background materials preparation, minutes keeping, feeding info to the ITA coordination e-platform, reporting/ analytics, liason with DPP secretariat;
- → Language: Ukrainian and English.
