The latest update on the development of the national blood system (1)

- The transition process of changing the organizational and legal form of management of regional and city specialized institutions and blood transfusion facilities from public institutions to municipal non-profit enterprises continued.
- Transfusion medicine departments were reorganized into hospital blood banks.
- Kyiv City Blood Center participated and successfully passed the assessment in the external international assessment of the quality of laboratory testing for markers of transfusion-transmissible infections (EQAS).

The latest update on the development of the national blood system (2)

- Quality management systems have been implemented in almost all specialized institutions and blood transfusion facilities, including ISO 13485:2016 Kharkiv Regional Blood Service Center, ISO EN 13485:2018 Kyiv City Blood Center.
- Barcoding of donor blood and its components and blood samples for laboratory testing in accordance with the international standard ISBT128, with the appropriate registration in the international database in Kyiv City Blood Center and Kharkiv Regional Blood Service Center.
